IMPORTANT TRAVEL INFORMATION & PACKING LIST for your BALI ADVENTURE:

We are excited to assist you in preparing for a tropical adventure by providing you with a packing list of important items.

Please read the whole document; some things are very important, such as the *Dos and Don'ts*, the information about your passport and visas, the Digital *Allindonesia* App, and the Tourist Tax.

☑ **THERE ARE NO VACCINE REQUIREMENTS;** they have been [revoked](#) and are **no longer required.**

☑ **A VISA on ARRIVAL** is available at **Immigration** or as an **E-Visa** for the amount of **500.000 RP**. You *can* pay it in cash at Immigration on arrival, but that takes much longer.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS TO BALI

As of September 1, 2025, entry requirements for Bali include completing the new "All Indonesia" digital arrival card, having a passport valid for at least six months, and paying the Bali tourism levy.

☑ **ALL INDONESIA ARRIVAL CARD:** This new digital form will become mandatory for arrivals at Bali's Ngurah Rai Airport (DPS) on September 1, 2025. There are two ways to fill out that information: Either by going online and filling out your details on the web or by downloading the app from the iOS store or Google Play Store.

☑ **ONLINE:** Fill out the complete free form online **up to three days (72 hours) before your flight** at allindonesia.imigrasi.go.id You will receive a QR code, which you must save on your phone or print to show at immigration and customs checkpoints.

PASSPORT: Your passport must be valid for at least six months from your date of entry. You also need a return or onward flight ticket to another country.

VISA: Depending on your nationality and length of stay, you may need a Visa on Arrival (VOA), an e-VOA, or a different visa type.

- **Visa on Arrival (VOA):** Available to citizens of many countries for a 30-day stay, extendable once. The fee is IDR 500,000 (about \$35 USD).
- **Electronic Visa on Arrival (e-VOA):** This option is recommended to save time and avoid airport queues. You can apply and pay online in advance through the official Indonesian e-Visa website, evisa.imigrasi.go.id.
- **Visa-Free Entry:** Citizens of certain countries (primarily ASEAN nations) can enter visa-free for up to 30 days, which cannot be extended.

TOURIST TAX/Bali Tourism Levy: All foreign tourists entering Bali are subject to a one-time levy of IDR 150,000 per person, which you can pay online. Go to [Welcome to Bali, the Island of Gods - Love Bali](#) or copy and paste <https://lovebali.baliprov.go.id/>

HOW TO PAY YOUR TOURIST TAX

Every foreign tourist is obliged to pay the Tourist Tax before arriving in Bali. **Paying tourist tax** in Bali is best done online through the **Love Bali website** or application.

Through **Love Bali**, tourists can fill in personal data information and then **get a QR code** after payment. **The QR code will be scanned by the officer** upon arrival at the Bali airport. Here is a step-by-step guide on how to pay your tourism Levy that you can follow:

- 1. Go to lovebali.baliprov.go.id** or download the **Love Bali App** from **Google Play Store** or **Apple App Store**. *(If your Browser does not open the Link automatically and then copy and paste it into another Browser.)*
- 2. Next, enter your personal and payment information**, such as passport number, name, email address, and arrival date.
- 3. Then, select the payment method;** there are various payment methods available to make it easier for tourists to pay the levy.
- 4. Complete the payment of Bali Tourism Tax**, which is **IDR 150,000** per person, according to the payment method that has been selected.

5. After successful payment, **tourists will get a levy voucher in the form of a QR code.**

The levy voucher will also be sent to your email. Make **sure the email you entered in the personal information form is valid and active.**

6. **The officer will scan the QR code** at the airport after your arrival in Bali.



Remember, you are traveling to the tropics. - 😊 The **weather** is tropical, **warm to hot**, with about a steady **29 Celsius / 85 Fahrenheit**, and a **humidity** of about **75%**.

The dry season, with very little rain, is **between April and December.**
The nights are coolest in July/August.

The wet season is between **late December** and the **beginning of April.**



Also, be prepared to encounter more wildlife - 😊 **in Bali.** You will see more critters and insects, such as ants, spiders, some mosquitoes, Geckos, even small rodents, and rarely ever a small scorpion. Many of these critters we are not used to encountering in the West. **Just remember, they are usually just a nuisance.**

We provide small refrigerators for your medicine, and most importantly, to keep all snacks or food away from pests. Please cooperate ❤️

Here are some suggestions of what to bring

Light clothing, because it's tropically warm. Bring beautiful, colorful, thin clothing.

For men, bring thin T-shirts, **sleeveless shirts**, and shorts.

A pair of leggings (if there are cooler times)

Socks for meditation periods in the morning

Yoga Clothing

Thin pajamas

- ✓ **Sarong / Wrap**, also good for the beach, go to a massage (can also be purchased in Shambala, 6-10 Euro maximum)
- ✓ **Sandals or Flip-Flops** or easy-to-get-off and on sandals, as you will be taking your shoes off often at the resort
- ✓ **House shoes if you wish**
- ✓ **Swimsuit or Bikini**
- ✓ **A lightweight fleece jacket** for possible cooler evenings and in the airplane
- ✓ **Toiletries**
- ✓ **toothpaste, shampoo, and conditioner.**
- ✓ **Shambala provides liquid soap.**
- ✓ **Sanitary napkins or tampons. *Shambala provides a paper bag to dispose of sanitary items.***
- ✓ **IMPORTANT:** Shambala uses septic systems and therefore requires that you ***do not throw anything but soiled toilet paper into the toilet.***
- ✓ **Towels and bath towels **are provided at Shambala****

ADDITIONAL ITEMS

- ✓ **Travel alarm clock**, *which is usually your cellphone*
- ✓ **Snorkel, Mask, and Fins** ***are available at Shambala***, but we will not have enough for everyone at the same time.
- ✓ **Plastic bag** for the boat ride if you are going out on a ***Dolphin Sunrise Watch*** and wish to protect your gear from water and or bring a snack
- ✓ **Biodegradable suntan lotion:** # 15 should be enough unless you have very sensitive skin and plan to be in the sun for a long time.
- ✓ **Sunglasses** **if** desired
- ✓ **Earplugs:** If you are a lighter sleeper, it is great to bring your own earplugs, **preferably silicon earplugs** *as sometimes the ocean waves are up, or the priests happen to conduct a ceremony at night ... what is beautiful and romantic ... or when the cocks crow, and if one wants to have rest time, or wants to sleep.*

FOR FUN

- Diary to journal**
- Book to read / Kindle**
- Pencils**
- MP3 player with headphones** if you like listening to your own music
- Backpack** (small) for Day Excursions
- Addresses for writing postcards**

FOR YOUR HEALTH

- Vitamins**
- Minerals - which are important because you sweat more, *LIQUID MINERALS*** are best, as we sweat more in the tropics and need minerals.
- Plaster/ Band-Aid /liquid Band-Aid**
- Personal medicines,**
- Charcoal Tablets**
- Disinfectant**
- Antibiotic cream** for scrapes and wounds, which is especially important in the tropics. You can get these in Bali easily and our staff can get them for you.
- Mosquito protection:** *All beds have mosquito nets. We also have an electric mosquito racket, which helps to catch any unwanted visitors.*
- Anti-Mosquito Spray:** is available at Shambala, at the Boutique, *where you can buy a biological and pleasant-smelling spray against mosquitoes.*
- For the ears:** Please bring a **small bottle of white vinegar**. It's good to **rinse out your ears** after bathing in the sea. *Prevention is better than nursing an earache.*

IMPORTANT TRAVEL PAPERS

- PASSPORT:** Your passport needs to be valid for at least 6 months at the time of entering Indonesia. **NONE of the pages in your passport are permitted to have ANY signs of damage, even the smallest of rips or watermarks.**

CREDIT CARDS/ATM

- There is NO MONEY CHANGER at SHAMBALA.
- The closest ATM is in TEJAKULA,** about 10 MINUTES by motorbike from SHAMBALA.

EXCHANGE MONEY


- There is **NO ATM** at Shambala.


If you need to exchange your money for the local IDR currency, please do it at the airport. PLEASE ALWAYS CHECK YOUR MONEY when you receive it.

- You can also find a money changer in UBUD, in KUTA, or the CANGGU area.

PAYMENT FOR EXTRA CHARGES at SHAMBALA



You can settle your bill, using a Credit Card , CASH, or Bank transfer **(WISE)** for charges such as Food, Massages, Modems, purchases at the Boutique, extra nights, etc.

- For Credit Card payments, we'll need to add a 3 % surcharge.
- For PayPal payments, we need to surcharge 4%.
